In the fall of 2024, we had six successful performances of our Storybook Ballet Series at the Halle Cultural Arts Center in Apex. In November, Infinity Ballet Theatre presented *The Wolf and the Toymaker*, and in December local audiences enjoyed our annual production of *Nutcracker Dances*.

In addition to these performances that are traditionally part of Infinity Ballet's season, IBT dancers had some unique opportunities to be on stage this year. Company members were invited to participate in State Ballet Theater of Ukraine's chinese dance in *The Nutcracker* performance at the Carolina Theater in Durham in December. Then in February, a group of 19 Infinity Ballet students performed in the State Ballet Theater of Ukraine's

lovely production of Sleeping Beauty at the Carolina Theater in the roles of knitters, peasants, kittens, and cupid dancers. Company member, Olivia Avants said this about these experiences:

I think participating in the State Ballet of Ukraine's Sleeping Beauty let me see how professional our studio is, especially in the standard for the quality of dancing. There is an expectation of precision and effort our staff tries to uphold, even though we're a pre-professional environment. You also get to see the efficiency backstage at the company, and even though we didn't speak to most of the dancers, the passion we all felt for this art connected us all.

Just last weekend, company dancers participated in the Apex Peakfest festival downtown, performing fun snippets from the upcoming *Steadfast Songs of Friendship* production. Lastly, company members were a special part of the Celebration of Life, featuring exquisite costumes made by the late Marilyn Vaillant. It was lovely to be a part of a memorable afternoon of eloquence and reverence in honor of this special lady.

Also, Mr. Valery Lantratov visited Infinity to share his vast knowledge and experience with a pure classical ballet workshop. Mr Lantratov is the Artistic Director of the Russian National Dance Foundation, a People's Artist of Russia, former dancer with the Moscow Stanislavsky Ballet and Kremlin Ballet, and a long-time friend and guest instructor at IBT.

Mr. Chad gave a modern workshop to wake up dancer's imaginations in February. Then, in another IBT annual tradition, ten of our dancers participated in the UNC School of the Arts Winter Festival weekend with dancers from all over the state.

Thank you to everyone who responded to our spring parent survey! The overwhelming majority shared that participating in IBT performances has been a positive experience. Families especially praised the quality of our venues, costumes, and artistic direction, often describing them as excellent.

You also offered thoughtful suggestions; here are few of those:

• Introduce performance expectations in class to help younger dancers feel more confident

- Host casual social events—like park meet-ups or group dinners—to build community outside of rehearsal
- Encourage teachers to actively invite dancers to participate in performances
- Consider bundling key updates into fewer emails

The survey feedback is being reviewed by not only IBT's faculty and staff, but also by the current Board of Trustees and officers.
